Dear President Xi,

I am alarmed to hear of the horrific regime of repression enacted by the governor of Xinjiang Province.

Ten percent, greater than one million persons of Uighur ethnicity have been arrested without charge and placed in an extensive network of concentration camps constructed by the current regime in Xinjiang. Here, they are forced to assimilate into Chinese culture through compulsory Mandarin language instruction and constant propaganda. They are separated from their families, their livelihoods, and their culture because of their unique ethnicity, which is guaranteed by your constitution.

I urge you to end this shameful and backward practice of ethnic cleansing and forced assimilation.
